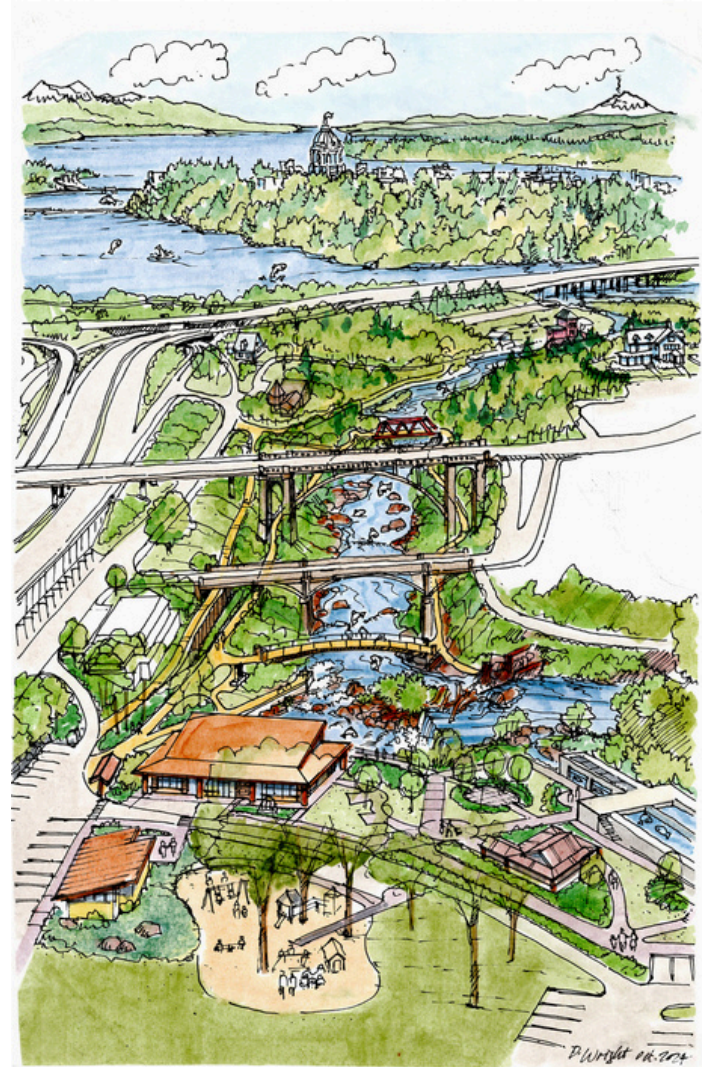




History and Nature Center at Brewery Park

Why It Matters

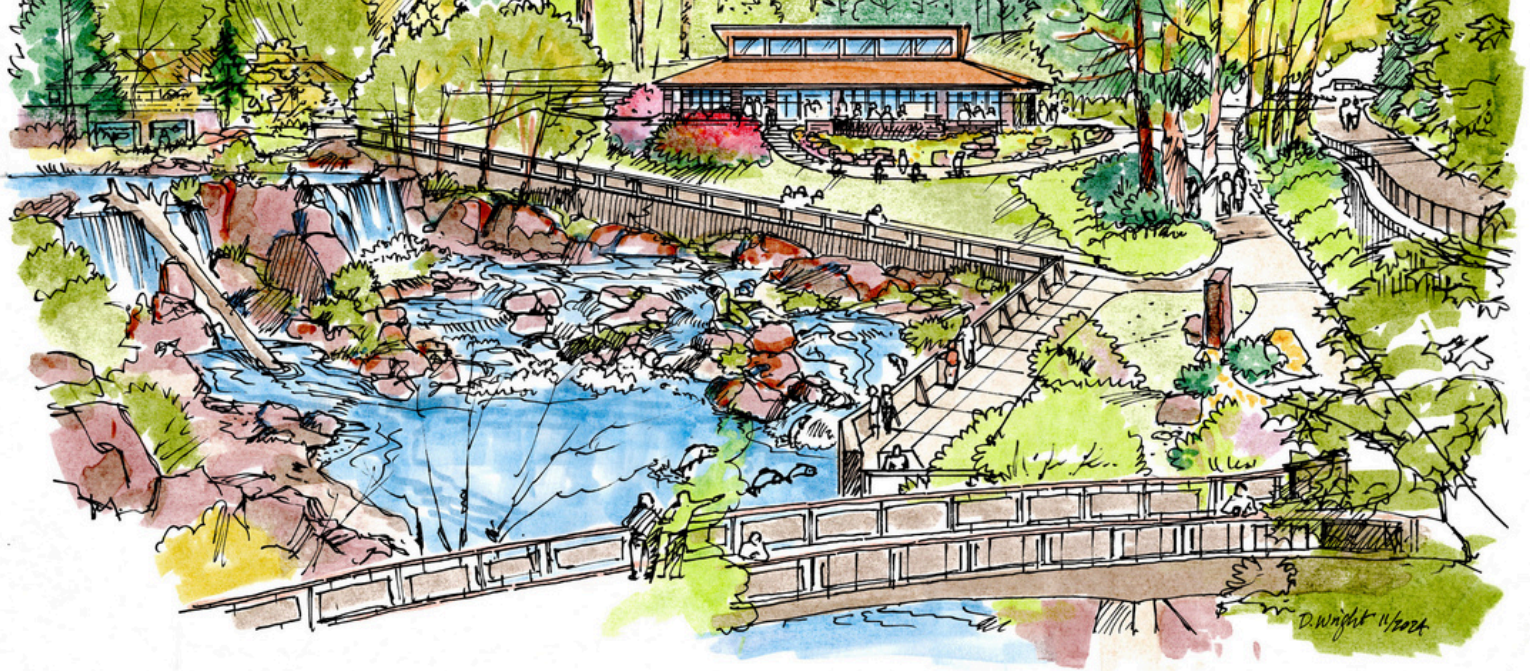
